Promotion of **education** in sustainability discourses

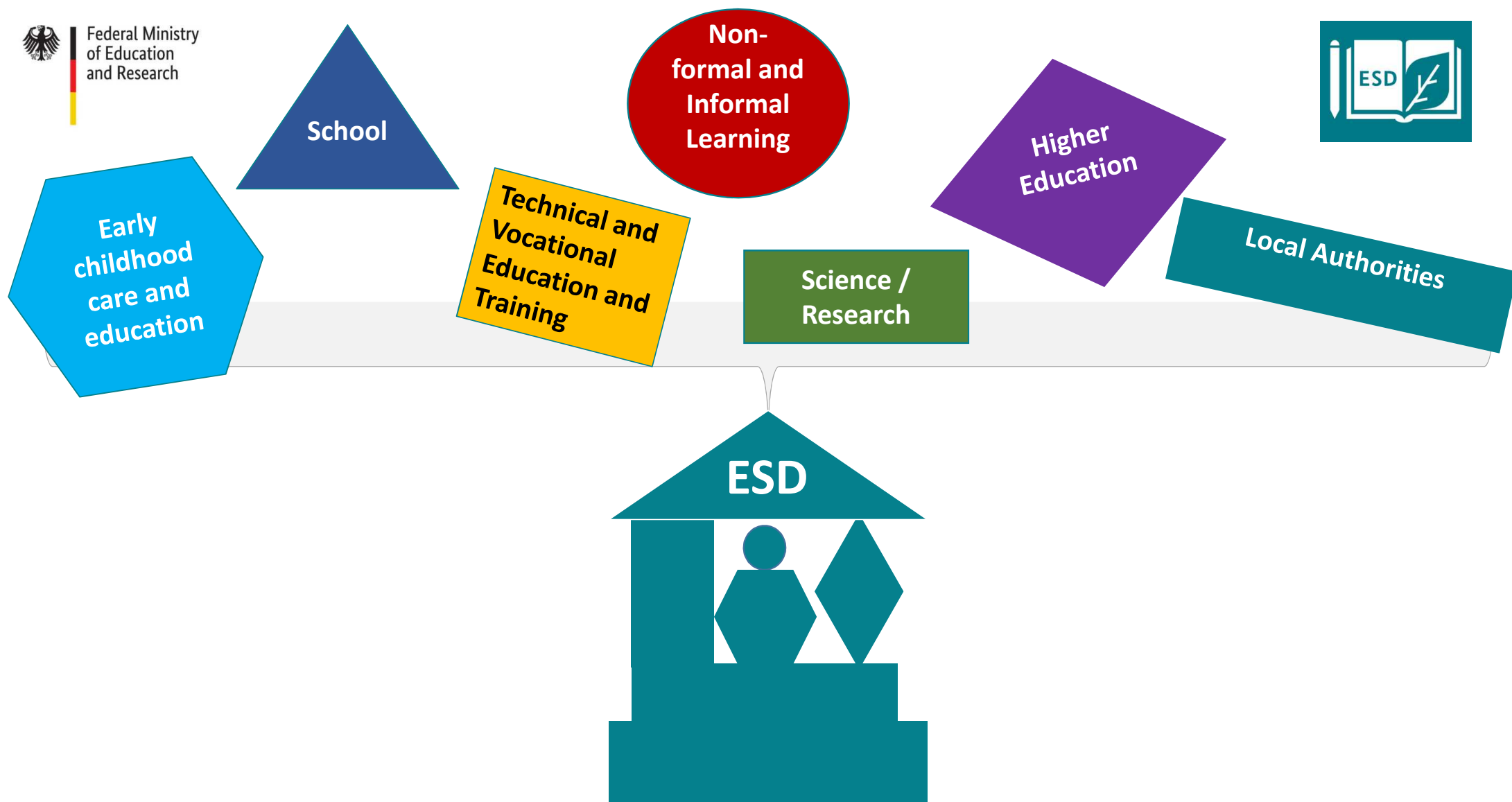

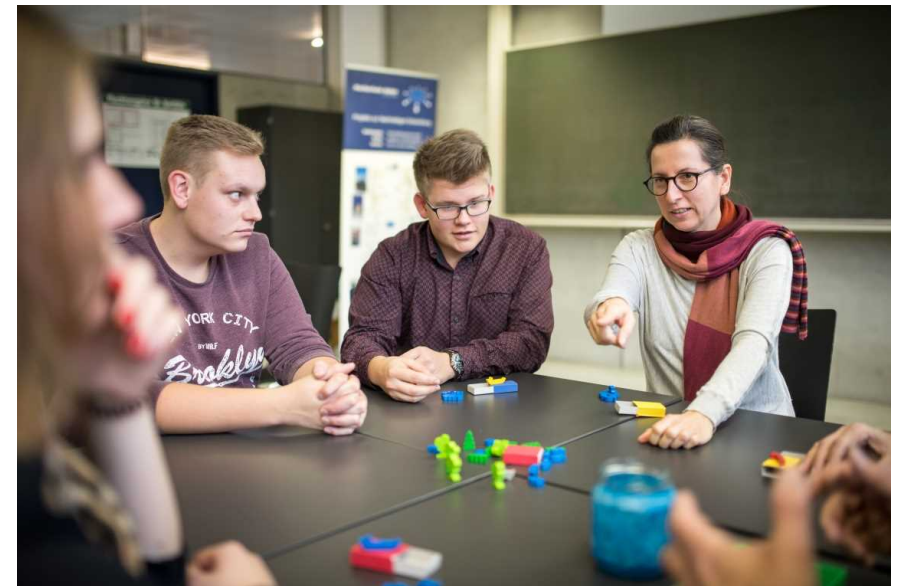
