Japanese Language Course for International Students	Preparatory Education	The Japanese Language Course for International Students teaches Japanese and fundamental subjects to foreign students who wish to enter Tokai University as an undergraduate or graduate student. In this preparatory course, students undertake a year-long course to develop their comprehensive skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing Japanese. Lessons in fundamental subjects such as Japanese studies are given for students specializing in liberal arts, while lessons in mathematics and physics are given for students specializing in science. After one semester, high achieving students with a good attendance record will be offered a recommendation admission or recommendation-transfer admission to undergraduate schools.
