In Japan, on the occasion of the 70th anniversary of its accession to UNESCO in 2021, “Youth Committee of the Japanese National Commission for UNESCO” was launched last October with the aim of making the voices of young people to be reflected to UNESCO activities both within Japan and worldwide. The Committee members has discussed and developed an action plan from their perspectives that will enable the youth generation both domestically and overseas to actively and continuously engage in the UNESCO activities.

In the Conference, young people around the world will discuss the plan for further development and take to the action.
