

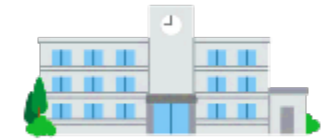

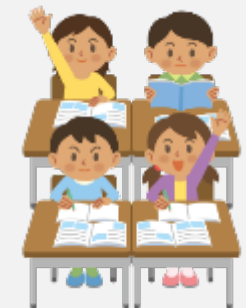

About the Videos

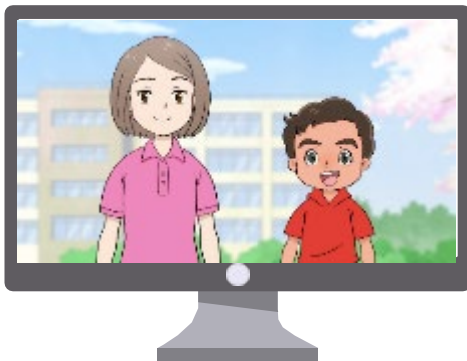
“Nice to Meet You! Let’s Be Friends!”
